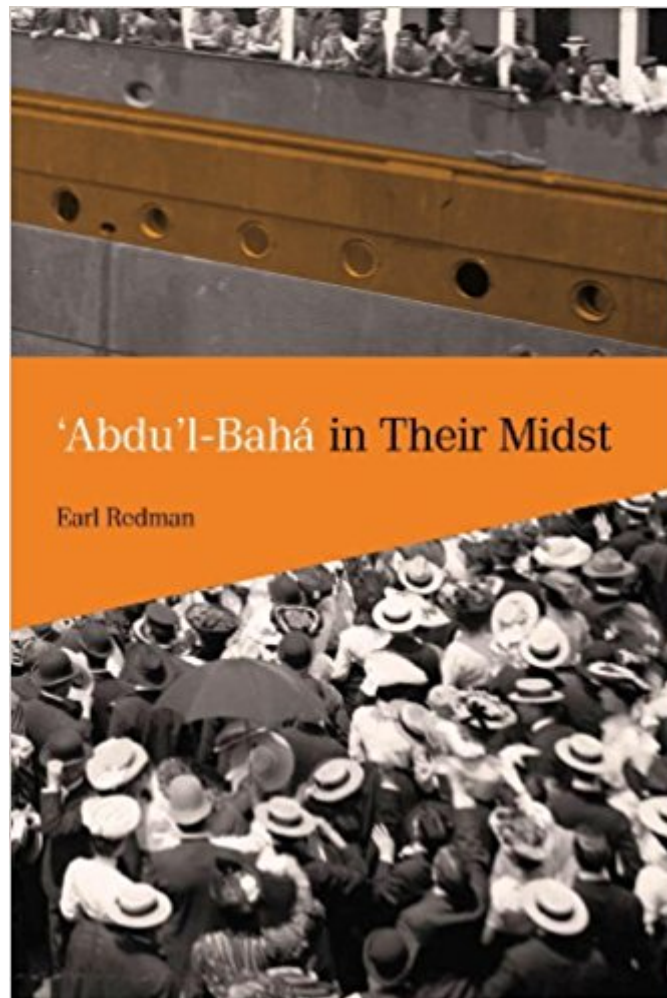

Some of the stories in the book moved me to tears. It is well-written and covers the journey of 'Abdu'l-Baha through the United States in 1912 - exactly 100 years ago. Organized in chronological order, also covers some of the time 'Abdu'l-Baha spent in Europe. I couldn't put it down!

For me, it's been a fun read - easy and entertaining. Redman has pulled together an entire book of incidents showing not just what Abdu'l-Baha did, but how people reacted to him. Because so many are a paragraph to a few pages, you can pick it up, read a bit, put it down and come back later. You can also get swept along for a couple hours. LOLI think it is a fine adjunct to the more formal histories of Abdu'l-Baha in the west.
